

Research Centre conditions of use

The Research Centre welcomes all visitors, including those who wish to view the displays or have a casual research inquiry, as well as those who wish to undertake long term research into Australia's prime ministers. As it is a study area, we ask however that you observe a few conditions of use to ensure both provision of an environment that is conducive to research and preservation of the collection.

Reading Room environment

- Bags and laptops can be brought into the Research Centre, however belongings may be inspected upon leaving
- Leave your mobile in your bag and switch it off, or on silent
- Do not make or receive calls on mobile phones
- Do not engage in loud conversation with others
- Generally be considerate of other researchers using the Research Centre
- Please obtain a Reader's Card from the Enquiries Desk if you are likely to be a regular visitor to the Centre
- Use of the internet is restricted to websites associated with research into Australia's prime ministers and related topics
- Please return books to the librarian to be re-shelved
- You may take photographs in the Research Centre and exhibition, but please respect the privacy of others in doing so
- Do not enter 'Staff Only' areas
- Note the location of EXIT signs for use in case of emergencies.

To assist with the preservation of our collection material please do not:

- Bring any food or drink into the Research Centre
- Use pens or ink – pencils only should be used in the Research Centre and have been provided for your use
- Remove collection material from the Research Centre
- Mark or annotate collection items in any way.

Electronic surveillance cameras are in operation in the Research Centre and exhibition.
